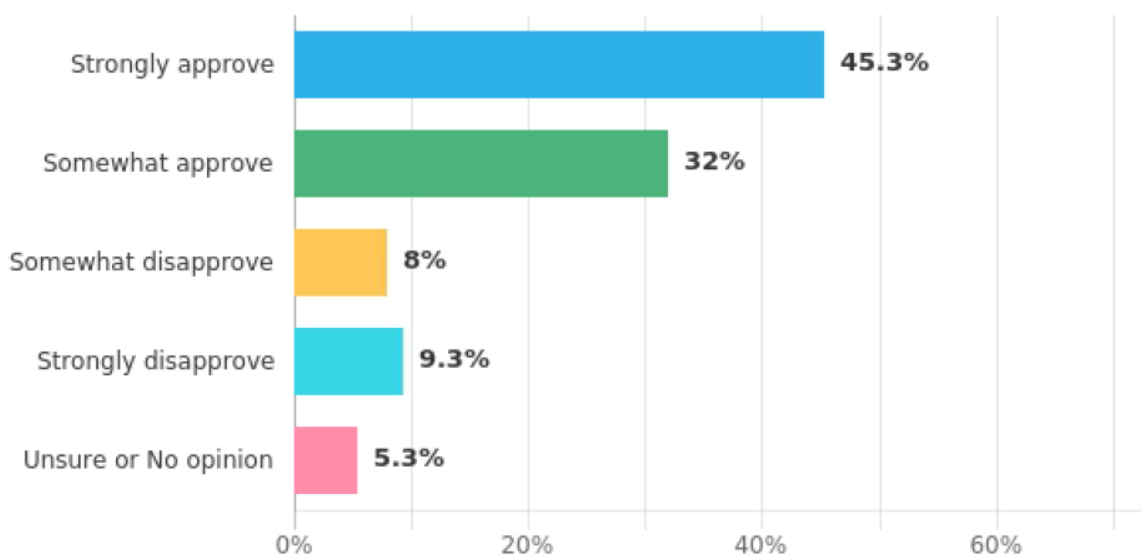


Voter ID Laws:

Georgia (sample size 600)

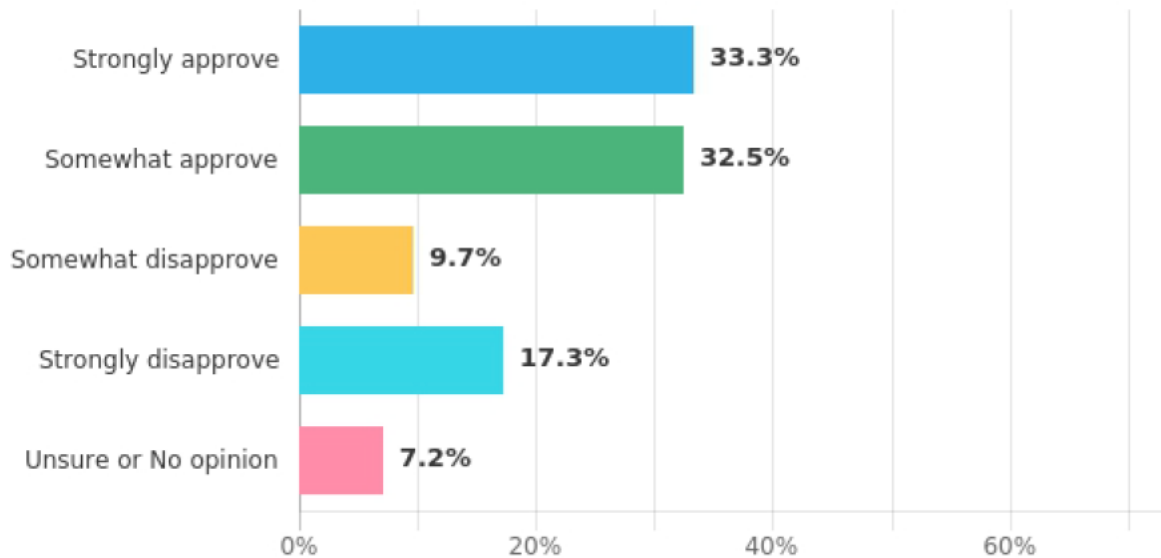

North Carolina (sample size 600)

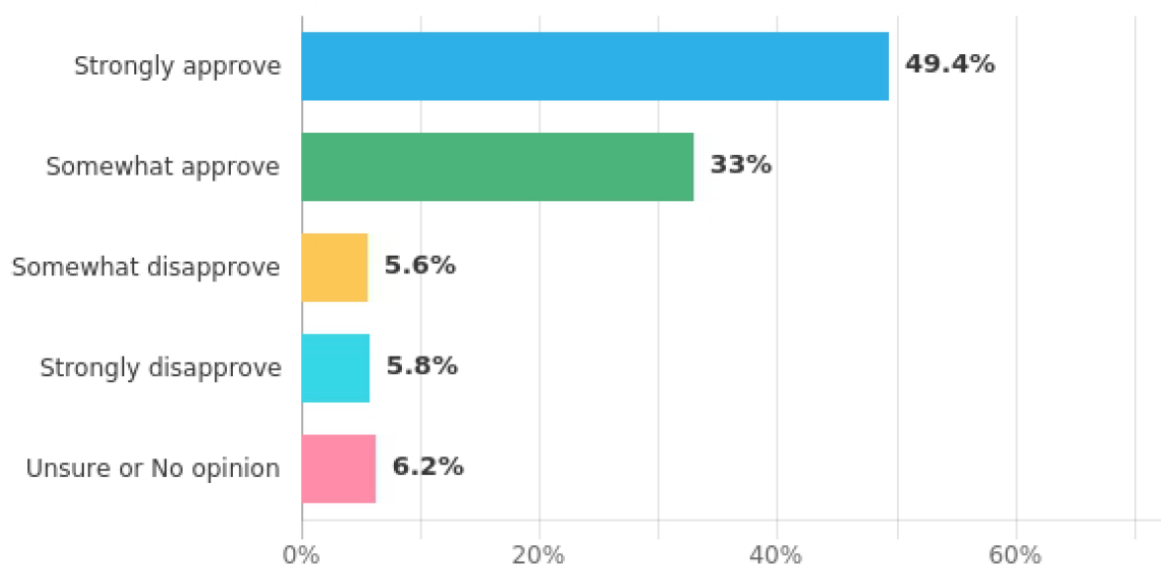
