The Commission reiterates that [RETAIN: the Universal Declaration of Human Rights,] the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Women and the Convention on the Rights of the Child, and the Optional Protocols [RETAIN: where ratified] thereto, as well as other relevant conventions and treaties, such as the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities, the International Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Racial Discrimination, the International Convention on the Protection of the Rights of All Migrant Workers and Members of Their Families provide an international legal framework and a comprehensive set of measures for realizing gender equality and the empowerment of all women and girls and the full and equal enjoyment of all [RETAIN: internationally agreed] human rights and fundamental freedoms by all women and girls, throughout their life course. It is concerned that the disproportionate impact on women and girls is deepening pre-existing inequalities, that perpetuate [DELETE: multiple and intersecting forms of] discrimination as well as racism, stigmatization and xenophobia, and that it has further exacerbated vulnerabilities in their social and economic situations as well as their safety, well-being and livelihood, including their access to essential health-care services, [DELETE: including access to sexual and reproductive health] and access to education. It further expresses deep concern over the increased demand for unpaid care and domestic work and the reported surge of all forms of violence, including sexual and gender-based violence, during confinement, as well as harmful practices, such as, child, early and forced marriage and female genital mutilation.
